Walking art tour of Bunmahon on Waterford's Copper Coast

Walk through the historic picturesque village with artist Orlaith Hamersley.

On this walking tour Orlaith will guide you to some beautiful locations ideal for plein-air sketching.

The tour will last approximately 4-5 hours and you will cover approximately 5 to 7 kilometres. You will be stop at between 8 to 10 locations depending on the tide, and weather conditions. You will get the opportunity to sketch a pretty street scene with a thatched cottage, dramatic cliff tops, secluded coves, a long sandy beach with sweeping dunes, a river and boats, some historic mining ruins, not to mention the local flora and fauna. Bunmahon has a fascinating history, particularly interesting is the 1914-1915 summer art school led by seminal Australian artist Margaret McPherson, Orlaith will tell you all about it during the tour.
